

## 2020-2021 School Year On-line Program



Registration Forms are available for download and print out at this location by clicking on this link [Register Here Button](#) or by clicking on the **Green Button** on the Religious Formation Page. We will keep the attendance day designation (Sunday or Wednesday) in order to keep track of students should in-person classes resume when the COVID19 restrictions are lifted. Lessons will be posted beginning with the third week of September. Sunday Lessons will be posted on Sunday on the on-line program calendar and Wednesday lessons will be posted on Wednesday on the on-line program. Accessible through the assigned user name and password.

Kindly use regular mail to return the completed registration forms, tuition check, baptismal certificate (entering Grade 1- and first-time registrations) and letters of transfer from previous parish, etc. Once your registration is processed, you will receive an email with the directions for access to the on-line program along with a user name and password. The on-line program is parent-child supervised and is user friendly with a simple format for one lesson each week. Keep in mind that all lessons must be completed to be eligible for the next instructional year and/or 2021 Summer Program instruction.

Sunday Mass attendance is part of religious formation. At the present time, Sunday Mass is available in-person and on livestream through YouTube and may be viewed at any convenient time. Details for the in-person Liturgy of the Word with Children (CLOW) will be posted in the parish bulletin.

Sacramental Preparation for Grade 2, 1<sup>st</sup> Reconciliation and 1<sup>st</sup> Eucharist, will be announced in the parish bulletin by *Ms. Lisa Considine*, the Volunteer Coordinator for this sacramental preparation.

Sacramental Preparation for Grades 7 & 8, Sacrament of Confirmation, will be announced in the parish bulletin by *Mr. Larry Boland*, the Volunteer Coordinator for this sacramental preparation.

Please keep in mind that all Catholic families are expected to provide formal religious instruction for Grades 1 through Grade 8 either through Catholic Schools or Parish Religious Formation programs. While it is a challenge during the pandemic, we will resume our regular programs as soon as the pandemic is declared over.

We appreciate your cooperation and participation in the provided user-friendly online learning modules. Additionally, all families must be registered parishioners to use our program.
